## **Sunnybank Theatre Covid Management**

## As at 5 April 2022 and continuing up to and including the 13th April 2022

Currently volunteers, audiences and anyone working at Sunnybank Theatre is required to provide evidence of being fully vaccinated/exempt in order to enter the premises. This has been in response to the restrictions imposed on all similar venues in the state and is a legal responsibility of the Sunnybank Theatre Committee to uphold.

We thank all volunteers and members for their support and understanding during these restrictions. Entry to the site will continue to be under these restrictions up to the 13<sup>th</sup> April 2022 (eg–Vaccination/exemption evidence required). Details of what evidence must be provided can be found HERE.

In addition, patrons are requested to not attend site if feeling unwell or if they are required to isolate (positive RAT/PCR or deemed a close contact). Exchanging your tickets to any future Sunnybank show will be available if this is case – simply call the box office.

We continue to be very conscious of the challenges with individuals being able to social distance and therefore continue to encourage everyone to:

- Wear a mask indoors
- Practice good social hygiene (wash hands/sanitise hands regularly)
- Socially distance (where possible),
- Have due consideration to other patrons/volunteers, some of which may be highly vulnerable.

To clarify, prior to the 14<sup>th</sup> April 2022, STG volunteers will continue to ensure all attendees have checked in using the <u>Check In Qld app</u> and show evidence of their compliant vaccination status prior to being admitted to the premises. We thank all those visiting the site for being prepared and providing this information to our volunteers at the door.

## Queensland regulations are changing on the 14th April 2022, what then?

Sunnybank Theatre will continue to comply to restrictions imposed by the State on an ongoing basis. As restrictions will be removed from the 14<sup>th</sup> April 2022 for those not vaccinated, we will conform to those relaxations and welcome all patrons and volunteers etc to the Sunnybank Theatre regardless of vaccination status. In addition, patrons/volunteers/contractors will no longer be required to check-in via the Qld App.

As was the case prior to restrictions being lifted, we seek our patron and volunteers support in keeping the venue as Covid safe as possible. This means that we encourage individuals to:

- Wear a mask indoors
- Practice good social hygiene (wash hands/sanitise hands regularly)
- Socially distance (where possible),
- Have due consideration to other patrons/volunteers, some of which may be highly vulnerable, regardless of your or their vaccination status/beliefs

In addition, patrons continue to be requested to not attend site if feeling unwell or if they are required to isolate (positive RAT/PCR or deemed a close contact). Exchanging your tickets to any future Sunnybank show will be available if this is case – simply call the box office. This position on

exchanges being available will remain in place until end of June 2022, when this will be reviewed by the Committee. In 'normal' times refunds and exchanges of tickets are not available.

If you have booked tickets for A little Murder Never Hurt Anyone for the weekend of the 15<sup>th</sup>/16<sup>th</sup> April 2022 and would prefer to exchange your ticket to the prior weekend (where unvaccinated patrons are not admitted without appropriate exemptions), please do contact the Box Office where we will endeavour to accommodate you.
